



The University of Kansas welcomes the opportunity for school and community groups to visit our campus and learn about the University. In order to provide a beneficial and enjoyable experience, please review our guidelines below:



- Chaperones must be present throughout the duration of the visit, including the campus tour and any presentation. Chaperones are responsible for making sure their tour group is respectful to all staff members, including our Student Ambassadors (tour guides) throughout the duration of the visit. Disruptive behavior may result in an abbreviated program. One chaperone is required for every 10 students.
- We ask that groups be respectful of their time and ours by arriving on time to the scheduled visit. Arriving late may result in a removed or shortened presentation or tour.
- Use of electronic devices by students (cell phones, gaming devices, tablets, etc...) during the presentation and/or tour is prohibited.
- The University of Kansas reserves the right to not schedule future visits if behavior of students is inappropriate or disruptive.
- We are only able to accommodate the number of students allowed per the registration form.
- Group visits are hosted at the Jayhawk Welcome Center, a state-of the art building with many exhibits showcasing the Jayhawk experience. We ask that all guests be careful with the interactive displays in the building.
